

MERRYBELLS

Uvularia grandiflora

Large Flower Bellwort



Description Native wildflower is a clump-forming, erect plant with somewhat bell-shaped, yellow flowers. Plant has a somewhat droopy appearance.

Natural Habitat: rich woodlands

Conservation Status: CONN & NH - endangered

Size: 1 ½ to 2 ft. tall – same spread

Growth Rate: Moderate

Light: Part shade

Planting and Care: moist, humus soil

Ornamental Value: Showy flower.

Landscape Usage An excellent native plant for the woodland garden, shaded border front, wildflower garden or naturalized area. Mass plantings under shade trees or along wood margins can be effective.

Commercial/Traditional Uses: Good cut flower
