Zenobia pulverulenta

Aka Dusty Zenobia, Honeycups



Description: Small to medium sized deciduous to semi-evergreen shrub. Leaves are covered in a fine down, green in summer, yellow to pale red in fall. Nodding white, anise scented flowers appear during Mar and June.

Natural Habitat: In pocosins and other moist area.

Conservation Status: Is it threatened or endangered in NC or any other state.

Size: 3-6 ft. tall with same spread

Growth Rate: Slow

Light: Sun to light shade

Planting and Care: Prefers moist, well drained acidic soil. Heat, humidity and rabbit tolerant.

Ornamental Value: Red leaves are especially attractive in the fall.

Landscape Usage: Used in a group planting in a naturalized garden.
