Coastal Speaker Series: How Clean Are Our Tidal Creeks? A Tidal Creek Report Card

WRIGHTSVILLE BEACH - How healthy is your local tidal creek? Tidal creeks provide habitat for many estuarine animals, and are vitally important to the region as fishing, boating, and swimming waters. As part of this month's Coastal Speak Series, Dr. Mike Mallin, water quality expert with UNCW's Center for Marine Science, will update us on the current condition of our waterways weaving throughout southeastern North Carolina. Dr. Mallin will highlight local sources and effects of stormwater runoff pollution, land use, and techniques on reducing stormwater runoff. Dr. Mallin also serves as the Research Coordinator for the Lower Cape Fear River Program and the Wilmington Watersheds Program.
