Cycling Event to Honor Coastal Steward, Jack Cleaves

OCEAN - On Saturday, Sept. 26 the North Carolina Coastal Federation will dedicate its annual Cycling for the Coast ride to longtime friend and supporter, the late Jack Cleaves of Swansboro, who passed away in September 2014. Cleaves was an avid cyclist and friend of the coast who demonstrated an unwavering commitment to the federation. Cleaves was honored for his dedication in 2006 when he received the federation's Volunteer of the Year Pelican Award.

"Jack was an inspiration that encouraged others to follow his example. His infectious smile encouraging others will truly be missed at this year's race," noted Sam Bland, a coastal specialist for the federation. "Jack contributed more than his share of time to making our coast more beautiful and a place we all can be proud of," added Bland.

The fifth annual bike ride will begin at 8 a.m., Saturday, Sept. 26 and travels along beautiful Bogue Banks. The family friendly ride offers 20K (12.4 miles), 40K (24.8 miles) and 80K (49.7 miles) distances. All cyclists will begin and end at Fort Macon State Park in Atlantic Beach. The event will continue with a post-ride celebration at the Idle Hour in Atlantic Beach.

Pre-registration is encouraged. Federation members can register for \$35, \$50 for nonmembers. Both fees include a Cycling for the Coast T-shirt plus lunch and beverages at the post-ride celebration.
