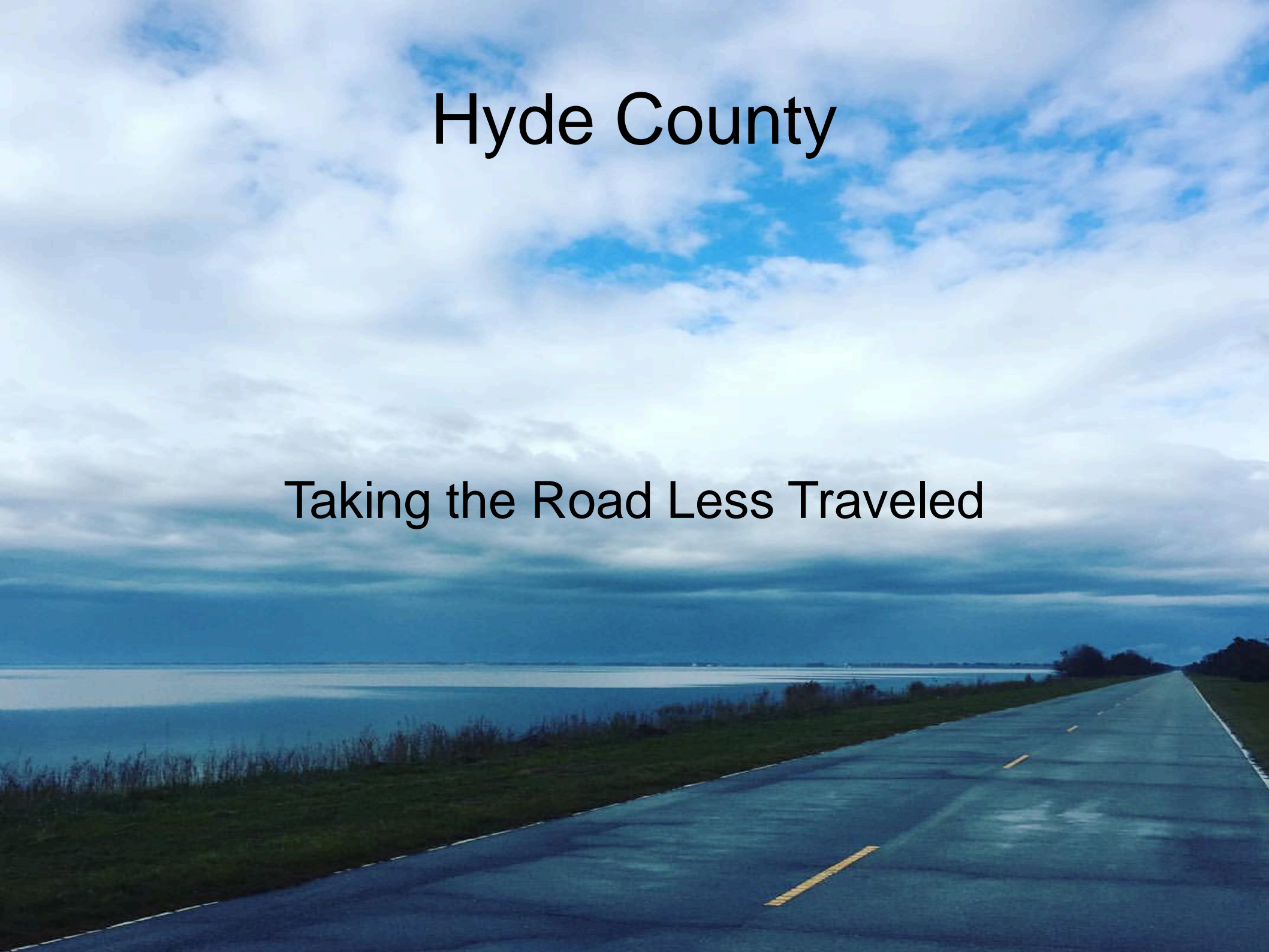
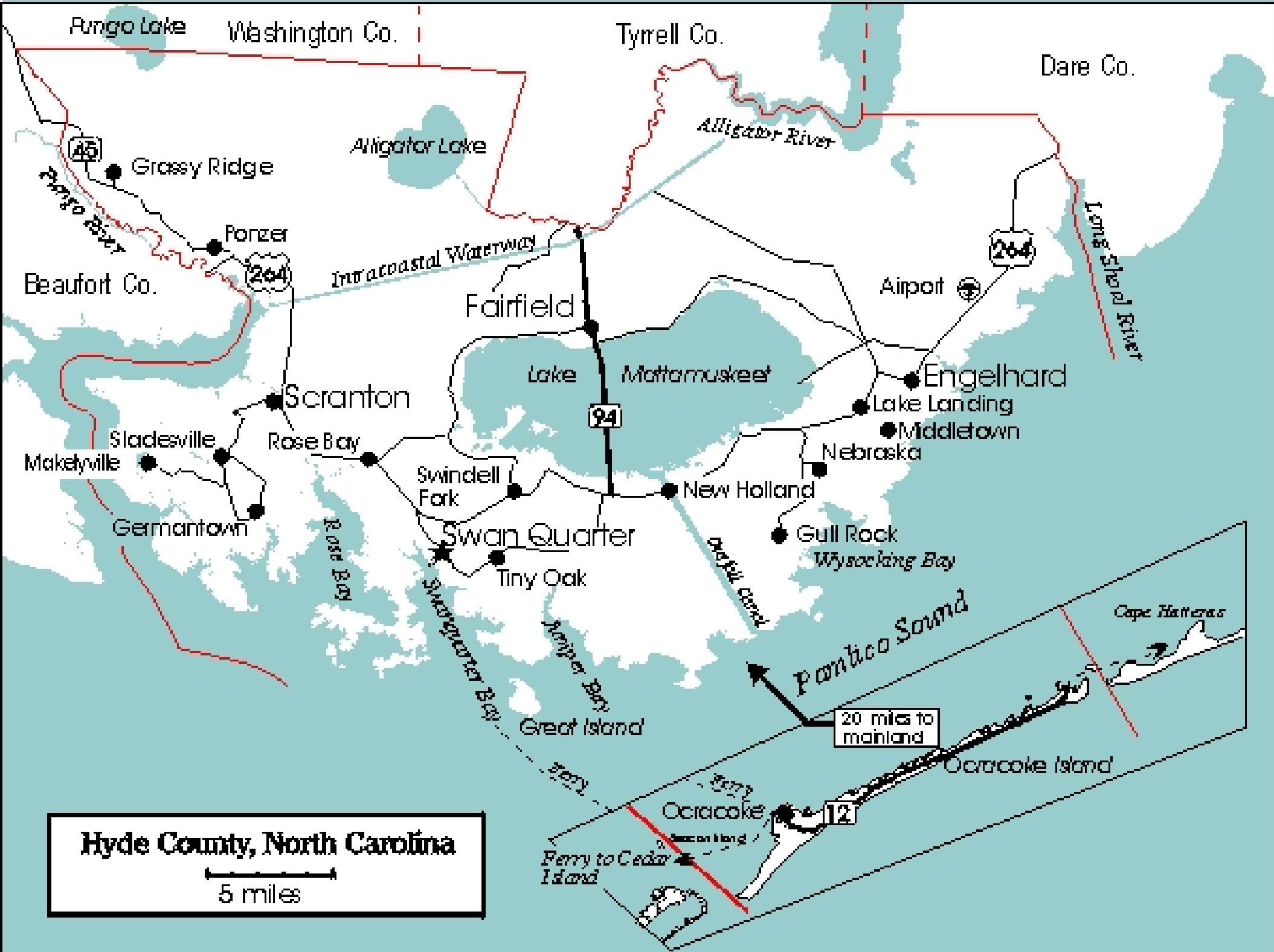




Hyde County

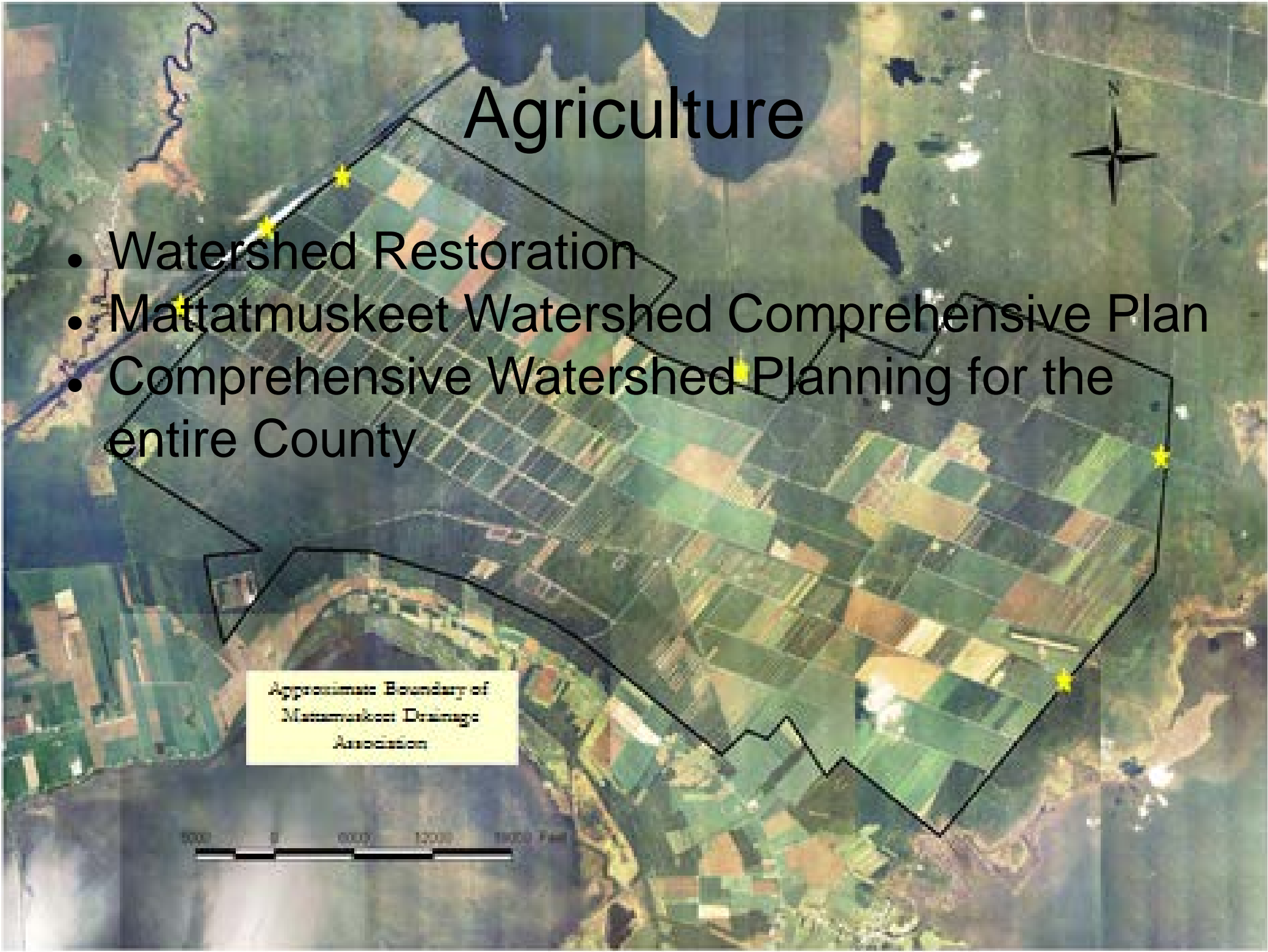
