2017 Summary of Major Accomplishments

The North Carolina Coastal Federation is the state's only nonprofit organization focused exclusively on protecting and restoring the coast of North Carolina through education, advocacy and restoration of coastal habitats and water quality. **In 2017 we:**



Restored over 16 acres of oyster reef



Restored nearly 45 acres of wetlands



Installed 67 stormwater reduction measures



Restored a half-mile of living shorelines



Prevented 275,000 gallons of runoff from entering coastal waters



Cleaned up 4,304 crab pots and 299 tons of marine debris



Reached over 250,000 readers and won 12 awards through *Coastal Review Online*



Engaged 1,052 volunteers



Educated 5,912 students — 60% from underserved groups/schools



Provided over 20 workshops, tours and trainings for citizens and community leaders

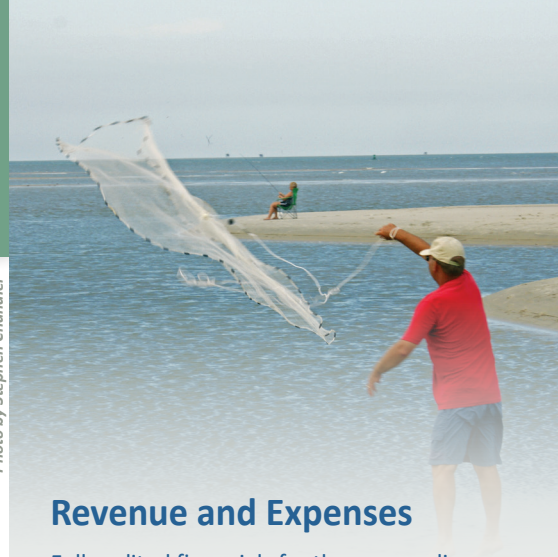


Protected the coast from offshore drilling and other polluting industries

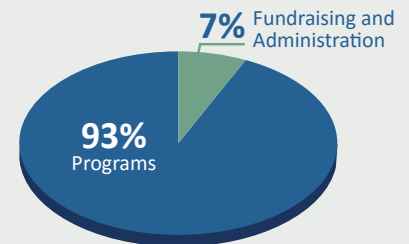

OUR MISSION

The North Carolina Coastal Federation empowers coastal residents and visitors from all walks of life to protect and restore the water quality and critically important natural habitats of the North Carolina coast.

In our 36-year history, the Coastal Federation has excelled at taking a creative approach to challenges, building relationships across traditional lines and finding interdisciplinary solutions. In 2017, we carried on that tradition by focusing on the economic importance of a healthy coast, demonstrating the economic benefits of habitat restoration

and sharing that information with our state leaders. We also forged a new partnership with the U.S. Department of Agriculture to restore 8,000 acres of wetlands over the next five years. We worked collaboratively to protect our coast from offshore oil and gas drilling and welcomed the support of Gov. Roy Cooper on that issue. We also strengthened our partnerships in underserved communities through youth education and environmental justice initiatives. Together, these partnerships make us strong – and our coast healthy.
