Current statute: "Compatible" with other public trust uses of estuarine resources

Result: Litigation—delay; taxing agency resources; creating uncertainty

Recommendation: "will not unreasonably interfere with other lawful utilization by the public of other marine and estuarine resources"

 - Onus on state

- Within SEA, mariculture by permit (not lease)

- Economics of production (shore facilities)
