





A North Carolina Coast Paddling Initiative

The Wrightsville Beach Outrigger Canoe Club and the North Carolina Coastal Federation are teaming up to tackle water issues along our coast.

Over three years, members of WBOCC are paddling the entire North Carolina coast to advocate for clean water, empower local communities, bring awareness of contamination and protect the most vital element of our lives: water.

The first leg along southeastern NC coast kicked off in 2022 when members paddled from Sunset Beach to Ocean, N.C. Roughly 120 miles, this journey told the story of the North Carolina coast – from threats and risks to solutions and triumphs – and how we can all make a difference in protecting and restoring the place we call home. This year in 2023, our paddlers will take on the Crystal Coast, paddling from Swansboro to Cape Hatteras – 100 miles in three days.
