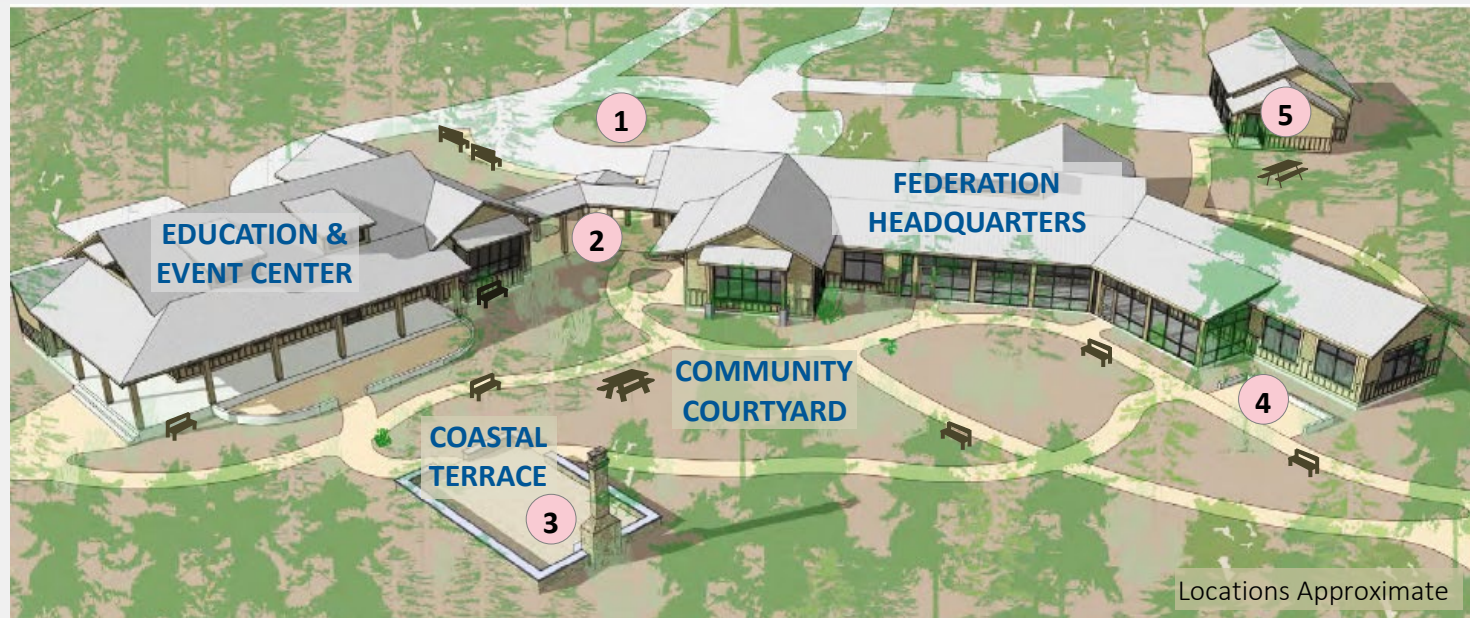
COMMUNITY COURTYARD - \$150,000

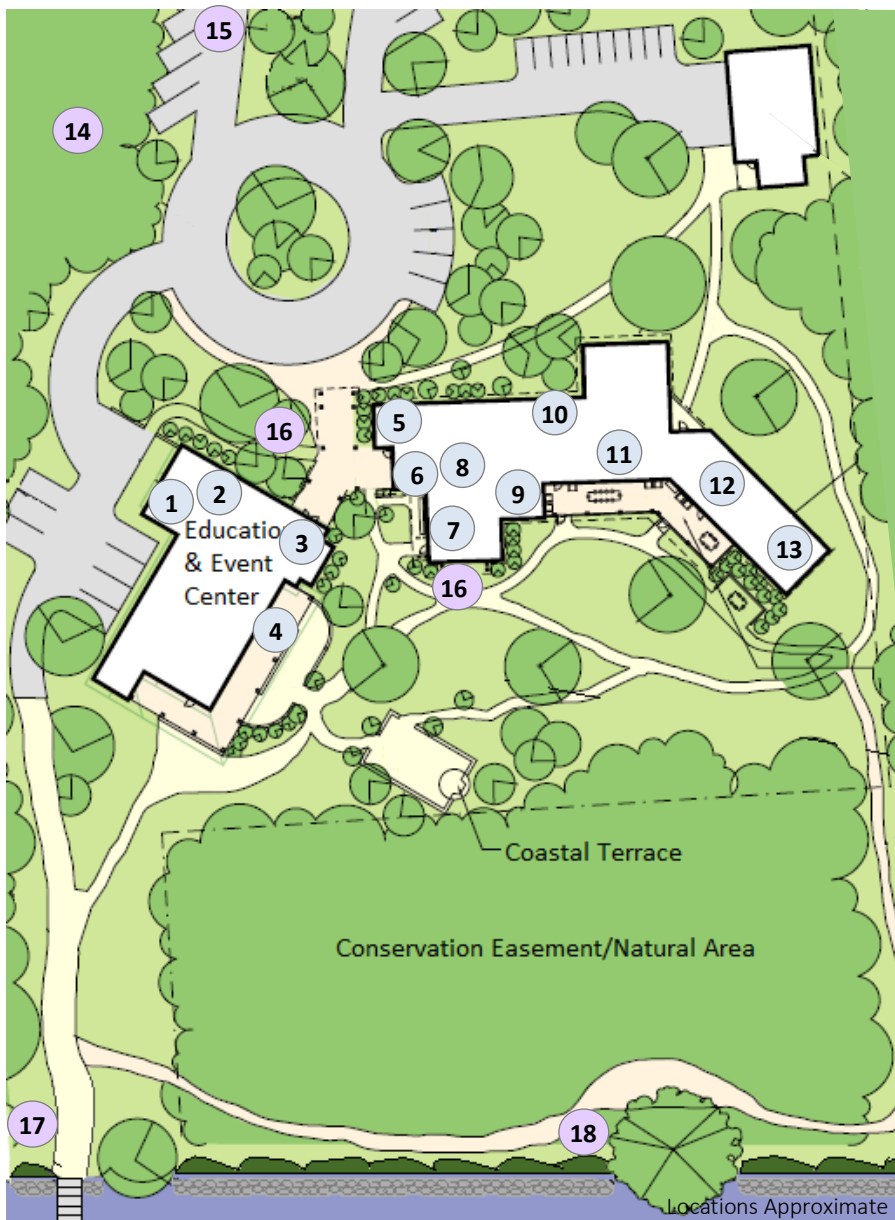

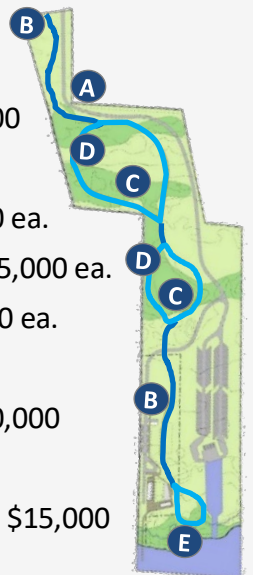
